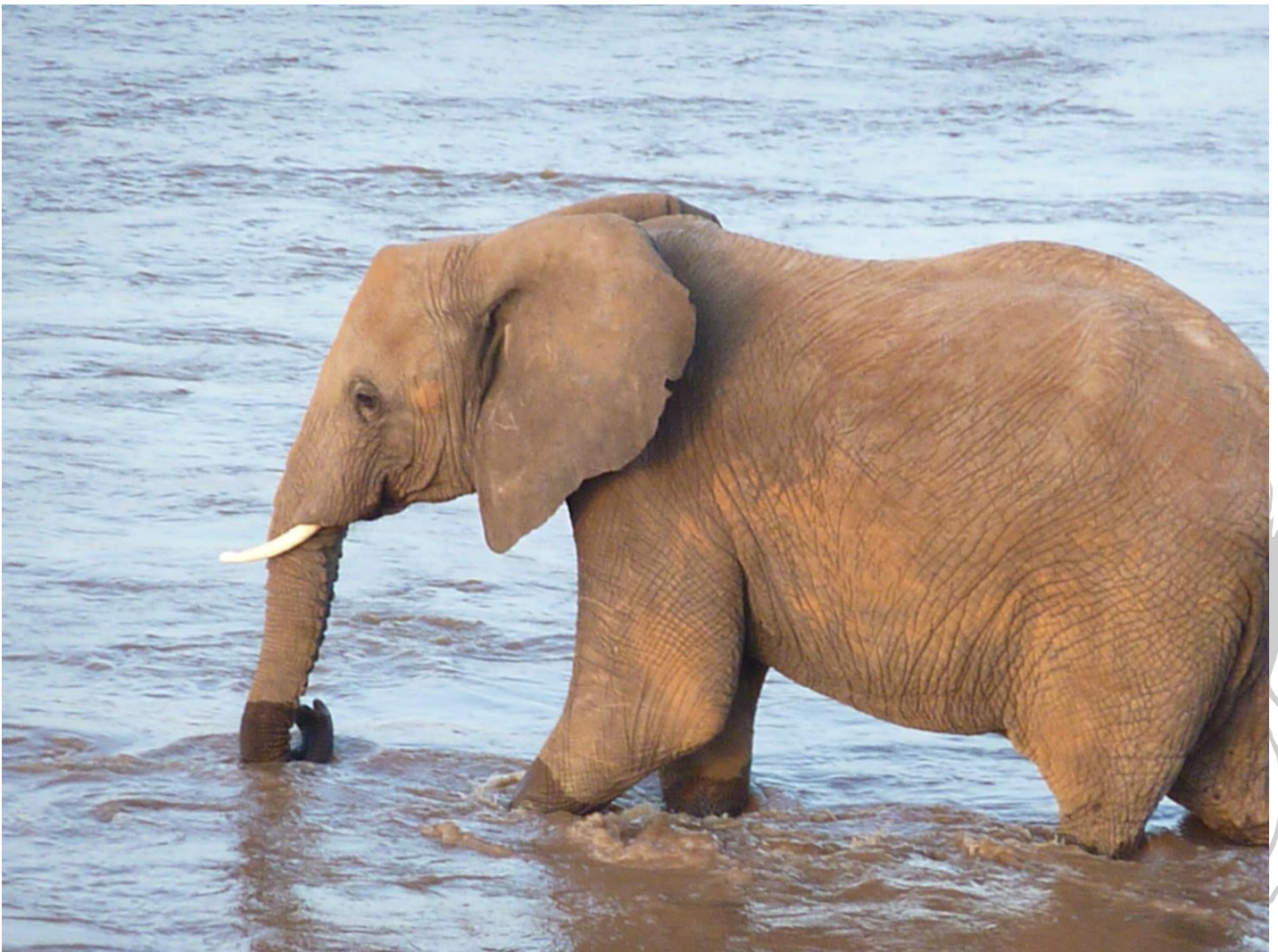
Day One & Two: Nairobi

Upon arrival, you will be transferred to the Ngong House. On day two, you will visit some of Nairobi city historic and conservation project. You will get to visit giraffe center, Daphne Sheldrick elephant orphanage and giraffe center. The afternoon is at leisure. Meals and overnight at the Giraffe Manor

Day Three & Five: SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE/ LEWA CONSERVANCY: ~ 1 hour

After breakfast you will be transferred to the local airport for your flight to the arid wildlife rich and scenic area of Samburu Game Reserve. Upon arrival, you will be met by your guide who will take you to the Saruni Camp. For the next three days, you will be doing game drives both in the private conservancy, Samburu and Buffalo Springs Game Reserves. Meals and overnight at the Saruni Luxury Tented Camp or equivalent. **(3B, 3L, 3D).**

Day Six - Nine: Samburu/ Lewa – Masai Mara ~ 1 1/2 hours of flying

Our next destination will be a one and a half flight to the world famous Masai Mara. For the next four days, we will traverse this wildlife rich reserve covering as many parts as we would to sample some of the best wildlife and scenic lands. You will be staying at the two sides of the Masai Mara, with the last two days in the private sanctuary bordering the National Reserve.

The Maasai Mara National Reserve is world famous for its great herds of wild game. All animals found in Kenya among the "big five" are found here. For the next 3 days we will be doing morning and afternoon game drives. While here you can visit the Masai villages or take a balloon ride (extra cost). The three nights will be spent at Kichwa Tembo Tented Camp in the Masai Mara and the last two days in a private conservancy. On top of its elephants, lions, cheetahs and other wildlife, the Mara provides the opportunity for witnessing the Great Wildebeest Migration. Meals and overnight at Kichwa Tembo Tented Camp or equivalent and the last two nights at Mara Plain/ Mara Toto. **(3B, 3L, 3D)**

NB: While in the Mara, you might consider taking the balloon ride. This is a one hour flight that ends with Champaign breakfast at the plains of the Masai Mara, the fill up pretty fast so early bookings advised. (Extra)



Day Ten-Thirteen: Masai Mara-Nairobi-Zanzibar ~ 3 hours of flight time

From Masai Mara, we fly to Nairobi and connect to Zanzibar and stay at the Matemwa Beach Retreat.

Day Fourteen: Zanzibar – Nairobi – Europe - Home

After an early breakfast, depart for the airport for your flight home via trip extension

Trip cost:

TOUR INCLUSIONS:

- All airport transfers in Kenya and Zanzibar
- Transportation while on safari in Kenya in 4 x 4 land cruiser
- Vehicles equipped with photographic roof hatch, sliding windows, ice
- Meals as specified in the itinerary;
- Accommodations as specified in the itinerary;
- Local flights in Kenya and to Zanzibar
- All park/ reserve/ conservation entrance fees;
- Flying Doctors' Insurance – within a radius of 1000 kms from the Wilson Airport in Nairobi (includes one free medical emergency air ambulance evacuation to the nearest medical center. It, however, **does not** cover any medical bills).

TOUR EXCLUSIONS:

- Tips to safari Driver/ Guides.
- Meals outside of those specified in the itinerary;
- Passport and visa fees;
- All items of a personal nature such as laundry, telephone calls, drinks, etc. unless stated

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

- 30% deposit payable upon confirmation of tour. 70% balance payable 45 days before commencement of services.

ALTERATIONS TO TOURS:

The right is reserved to change any route or arrangements should conditions so necessitate, to offer substitutes of equal value, or to cancel the operation of any scheduled tour. The right is also reserved to decline to accept or retain any person as a member of any tour at any time, in which event an equitable amount will be refunded.

Insurance. Wilderness Zones strongly advises participants to purchase travel protection insurance. Due to unexpected events, illness, and emergencies, Participants risk losing all or part of their travel investment. In the absence of travel protection insurance, Participants are not covered for any losses sustained in addition to tour costs, such as medical expenses, baggage loss, and death benefits. There are a number of policies available, varying in the extent and type of coverage, as well as the cost. Typically, the policies do not cover losses incurred due to civil disturbances, war, terrorism, or insolvency of tour operator. Participants are not required to purchase this or any other travel protection insurance in order to participate in the tour package, but again, such coverage is strongly recommended for the reasons stated above.
